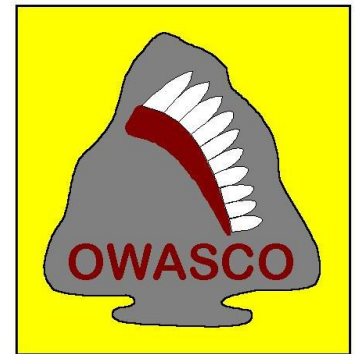


OWASCO AREA COMMISSIONER

You are invited to submit your application for the volunteer position of Area Commissioner.

Scouts Canada is a volunteer led, staff supported organization. The Area Commissioner is the Area's Chief Volunteer Operating Officer, responsible for all aspects of the administration of the Area and of program implementation, delivery, service and support. The Commissioner provides leadership to the Volunteers in the area, assisted by a team of Deputy Area Commissioners and Group Commissioners. This position provides the opportunity to demonstrate decision-making, recruiting, coaching, mentoring, planning and problem-solving skills.

Appointed by and accountable to the Council Commissioner of White Pine Council, you will be required to donate 20 to 24 hours per month (on average) to this position. As Area Commissioner, you will work closely with your Service Team and be principle contact for your Area.

You will play a key role in ensuring your Action Plan is consistent with the Scouts Canada Action Plan and Strategic Directions. As Area Commissioner, you will represent your Area at White Pine Council meetings and conferences.

Your upbeat, positive attitude will encourage a climate favourable for growth. You will support the promotion of all seven programs currently offered for youth aged 5 to 26. You will selectively recruit, orient and appoint other volunteers for your Area Leadership Team.
