## 2010/11 Beaver Buggies Fun Day

### GUIDELINES AND EXPLANATION



**It starts with Scouts.**

Beaver Fun Day is a morning event that includes Beaver Buggies as one of the stations that the colonies participate in. This format is setup since there are too many beavers to have everyone at the track at once, and there is not enough resources/money to have a day long event to run separate meeting times for each colony.

Registration deadline: See registration form or AAC Colony – Owasco Area (contact info below)  
We need approximately 100 registrations in order to pay for the rental of the school, so please do register ASAP or at least on time so the event does not get canceled.

Fees: See registration form or AAC Colony – Owasco Area (contact info below)

A preparation “Assembly” night will be held for each group for the beavers to assemble their buggies. This preparation can be done by each colony on their own, or the AAC Colony can attend your meeting and assist (and bring hammers etc as needed).

The groups colony leader(s) will gather buggies to bring to the Saturday Fun Day. It is not recommended to send buggies home with youth as they may get broken/lost at home and the beaver will not have a buggy to run on the Saturday. Beavers should take their buggies home at the end of the Fun Day.

Groups must have their buggies already assembled prior to the Saturday event, since there will not be time for assembly or paint drying at the event.

Groups that have already purchased their beaver buggies will have a reduced fee for the Beaver Buggies Fun Day exactly the cost of the buggy itself.

This is a “round robin” multiple station event, sort of like a mini beaveree, only events are put on by the committee, and it’s a half day schedule, which is as follows:

8:30AM committee arrives and begin setup, only leaders may arrive

9 to 9:30 registration and parents and leaders arrival, supervise your youth until opening

9:30-9:40 gathering song/activity, opening, announcements

9:40-10:00 rotation 1

10:00-10:20 rotation 2

10:20-10:40 rotation 3

10:40-11:00 snack (busy activity for fast eaters)

11:00-11:20 rotation 4

11:20-11:40 rotation 5

11:40-12:00 rotation 6

12:00 closing

12:05 youth boots on and go home, committee pack up and leave

12:30 gym vacated

#### NOTES:

Committee will provide the morning snack, please ensure forms are filled out with any dietary concerns. Each registered youth will be assigned a number after registration is received. The number should be written on the buggy (even on bottom is OK, or on duct tape or tag attached to car).

Either number or name MUST be on each buggy.

Each registered youth will be given a special name tag, please make sure registration forms include beavers names. If you need to add 1 or 2 names after the registration deadline, we may be able to do that if there is room, please provide those names and fees prior to the event.

Beavers and leaders are to arrive and depart in full uniform. Necker must be worn at all times. If youth want to remove their vest PLEASE make sure their name is on the vest somewhere.

Leaders may be asked to assist with the running of events, so please be ready to share the leadership!

All events will be non-competitive in nature, including the runoff, as everyone will get a first place for something in the “track” event, and we are there for a fun time!
