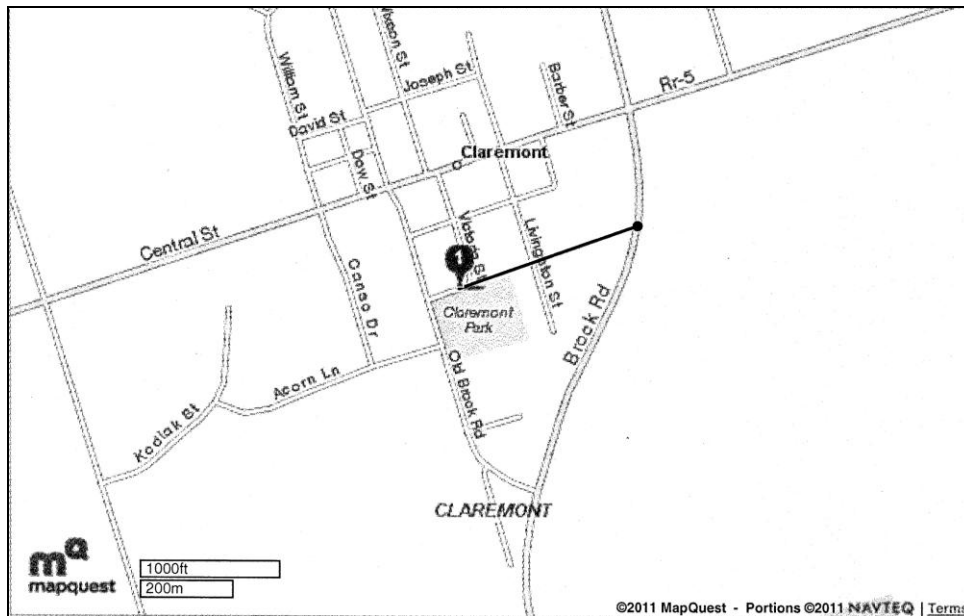


Kub Kars Races

Pack Run-off

The run-off will take place at the Claremont Community Centre (South West of Brock Rd & Central St/RR#5).



Directions to Claremont Community Centre

- Go north on Brock Road, past the lights at Hwy #7/407 Exit.
- Continue north past 7th and 8th Concession.
- After 8th Concession (about 1.5 kilometers) you will see the lights at Central St/RR#5.
- About 500 meters before the lights, turn left onto Old Brock Rd.
- Follow Old Brock Rd for about 400 meters. Parking for the Community Centre is on your right, next to the baseball diamond. The Fire Hall is also next to the Community Centre.

- Should you miss the left turn onto Old Brock Rd, continue to the lights (Central St/RR#5) and turn left.
- Go west along Central Street and turn left at the 4th street (Old Brock Rd).
- Follow Old Brock Rd south for about 400 meters. Parking for the Community Centre will be on your left, next to the baseball diamond. The Fire Hall is also next to the Community Centre.

The early registration fee this year is \$5.00. The cost of the Kub Kar kit is separate and must be purchased at the Scout Shop. The Scout Shop does not carry a large stock of kits, so please contact them at 1-905-725-5722 to place your order at least 1 week in advance.

Important Dates

Early registration deadline: **Tuesday, February 14, 2012**

- Registration cost is \$5.00

Late registration: **February 15 – February 26, 2012**

- Late registration cost is \$10.00

After February 26, 2012

- Registration is closed. No registrations will be accepted.

A complete registration package includes the registration sheet, preferred runoff dates/times and your registration fee. **You will not be given a runoff date and time unless all 3 have been received.**

You can submit your registration package through your Group Commissioner, who can deliver it to me at the Area meetings, held on the 2nd Tuesday of each month. If you prefer, you can leave your registration package in my mailbox at 1971 Fairport Road, in Pickering (Finch & Fairport), but remember to leave me a message (416 358-9391) telling me you did so. Registration Sheet

Included below are the registration sheets. The completed sheet(s) should include the full name of each Cub who is participating, their car number (see [Group Allotted Car Numbers](#)) and whether they are registering in the “Design – Cub Only” or “Design – Cub with help” category. Every car automatically qualifies for the “Speed” category and will race. If you are unsure as to which category they should be registered in, below are some guidelines. If you are still unsure, don’t worry, as it will be clarified at the time of registration.

“Design – Cub Only” vs. “Design – Cub with Help”

An adult can only help put on the wheels and any weights **“Design – Cub Only”**. If an adult helps in any other aspect (design, cutting, painting, etc), then this is considered **“Design – Cub with Help”**.

NOTE:

The “Design – Cub with Help” category should be just that, “Cub with Help” and not “Adult with Cub Help”. In all fairness, your Cub should be doing the majority of the work, with some help and guidance from an adult.

Pack Races

Pack run-off dates are:

- Saturday, April 14
- Sunday, April 15

A schedule will periodically be posted on the website as groups register.

Your run-off time will be 2½ hours and is divided into the following 4 time slots.

1. ½ hour for registration
2. ½ hour for voting for design
3. 1 hour for racing
4. ½ hour for trophy presentation

Each pack should arrive on time and be ready to race. There will be a pit stop available for last minute adjustments to cars, but this should not be used to finish your car – please be prepared!

Area judging is done by an independent panel of judges and any car that appears to be more “Adult with Cub Help” rather than “Cub with Adult Help”, will not be considered for a trophy.

Leaders/Adult and Sr. Youth Race

Who says only the youth get to have fun? We might have a few years on them, but we’re still young at heart. Come out experience the thrill and excitement of putting on that safety helmet and screaming **VROOOOOOM! VROOOOOOM!**

All this will take place on **Sunday, April 22, 2012**. Registration time will be 9:00 AM. Judging for design will start around 9:30, immediately followed by the races.

For any leader, adult or Sr. youth wishing to register please include their name at the bottom of the Pack registration sheet along with their car number. **Remember to send me a note as well as a Cheque for their registration.** If you do not have enough car numbers allocated to your pack, please give me a call and I will assign you additional numbers.

Area Finals

The top 3 winners in each category for each Pack will go on to the Area finals being held on **Saturday, April 21, 2012**

Winners will register for the Area finals in the same category that they won at the Pack level. In other words, if you win in “Speed” at the Pack level, you will be registered for “Speed” in the Area finals. If you win in “Design” at the Pack level, you will be registered in the corresponding “Design” category in the Area finals – your car will not race.

Speed

- Registration for winners in the “Speed” category will be 9:00 AM.
- Once we have enough cars registered, we will start racing, which should be around 9:30 AM. Late registrations might not be eligible to race, so please ensure you arrive by 9:00 AM to guarantee your spot. Plan to be racing for the entire morning – if you continue to win in your heat, you continue to race!
- Trophy presentations will follow shortly after the final heats, around 12:00-12:30 PM.

Design

- Registration for winners in the “Design – Cub Only” and “Design – Cub with Help” categories will be 10:00 AM.
- Once your car has been registered, you may choose to stay and watch the “Speed” races or leave and then return around 12:00 PM.
- Trophy presentations will be shortly after the end of the final heats for the “Speed” category, around 12:00-12:30 PM.

Questions & Answers

What do I need to do to prepare for our Pack Run-off?

Try to plan a weigh-in night 2-3 weeks prior to your run-off date. Here you can inspect the cars, check them against the height, width, length and weight restrictions. Provide each Cub with a sheet with a pass/fail for each restriction as well as the weight of their car. Also provide a note detailing the areas that need adjustments. You can even hold a mock run-off. All you need is some plywood wide enough for a makeshift 2-lane track and you're "**Off to the races**"!

Although the maximum weight of the car cannot exceed 145 grams, it is not critical that the car weigh exactly 145 grams. In years past, some of the fastest cars weighed less than 140 grams! A lot has to do with the alignment of the wheels, the arrow dynamics of the design and weight distribution. However, a minimum of 110 grams is necessary in order to ensure that the car can make it down the track and to the finish line.

Most importantly, it's not winning that counts, it's having fun!

REMEMBER TO OBTAIN AN OUTING FORM!

This is not just an outing for the Pack. Invite parents, grandparents, cousins, aunts, uncles, best friends etc – all are welcome! Remember, to bring your camera (and aspirin – the excitement of the Cubs can be deafening).

Also very important, don't forget the BEAVERS!

This is a great linking opportunity as well as an excellent retention tool. What better way to excite these future Cubs and to get them eager to move up to Cubs, than by exposing them to the wonderful world of Kub Kars!

What do I do when I arrive (in uniform)?

- Go directly to the registration desk and hand in your Pack registration sheet.
- Organize your Cubs in single file to register their car.
- Help any Cub whose car needs adjustments.
(Once the car is registered, it cannot be modified at any time thereafter)
- Organize your Cubs to where they can watch the current races in progress (unless you're the first run-off of the day).

What happens next?

Voting

Once all cars have been registered, they will be taken and placed on tables designated for each of the 2 design categories. All adults, parents and leaders will be asked to vote on the cars for design. Sorry, youth are not permitted to vote!

Racing

After the voting, the cars will be placed in heats and the racing will begin.

Trophies

After the final race has been run, the cars will be brought to the far back corner of the hall for the trophy presentations. Organize your Cubs and bring them over. When the trophy presentations are completed, you will be free to stay and watch some more or to go home and celebrate the day.

One of my Cubs can't make it!

If a Cub cannot attend the Pack or Area run-off, please make arrangements to have someone bring the car and register it anyway. We will always have someone willing to race the car for him or her. Not being able to attend does not disqualify you from participating.

Hungry? Thirsty? Do I need to bring any food?

There will be a snack bar selling; coffee, tea, pop, chips, candies, hotdogs, peameal-on-a-kaiser etc, so bring spare change and your appetite.

Remember, all money raised is used to help reduce the cost of the event, so please encourage your parents to arrive hungry and frequent the canteen often.
